one choice in Skill Enhancement courses. NEP 2020 envisions a new vision that enable an individual to study one or more specialized areas of interest at a deep level, and also develop capabilities across a range of disciplines including Sciences, Social Sciences, Arts, Humanities, Languages, as well as Professional, Technical and Vocational subjects.

It is proposed that in every academic year w.e.f. from 2024 to 2028, one course /semester will be added to the Ability Enhancement Courses bucket. Likewise, one course /semester will also be added to the Skill Enhancement courses. This will increase the accessibility to different courses to the enrolled learners. The list (**Encl-II**) is attached to review the courses as well as categorization of programmes and courses for approval.

Presently, seven posts of Director are sanctioned by Govt. of U.P. and all are filled. The two schools namely, School of Vocational Studies and School of Computer & Information Science are officiated by faculty of two other schools as In-charges. UGC DEB marked a deficiency in application submitted for recognition of programmes from session 2023 onwards indicating the officiating nature of In-charges. The two schools do not have any regular faculty which create the academic set up to these two schools. NEP-2020 envisions the use of technology and focuses on the design and development of curriculum and skill-based programmes through these schools viz; School of Computer & Information Science and School of Vocational Studies.
