The School of Education of the U P Rajarshi Tandon Open University, Prayagraj (U.P.) started the B Ed and B Ed Special Education teacher education programmes through ODL mode in the years 2003 and 2005 respectively. After India signed and ratified the UNCRPD in 2007, the process of enacting a new legislation in place of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995 (PWD Act, 1995) began in 2010 to make it compliant with the UNCRPD. After series of consultation meetings and drafting process, the Rights of PWD Act, 2016 (RPWD Act, 2016) was passed by both the houses of the Parliament. It was notified on December 28, 2016 after receiving the presidential assent. The RPWD Act, 2016 provides that “the appropriate Government shall ensure that the PWD enjoy the right to equality, life with dignity, and respect for his or her own integrity equally with others.” Awareness and sensitization programs are to be conducted and promoted regarding the PWD. This Act is more comprehensive than the Persons with Disability (PWD) Act, 1995. It presents many challenges before school education. Nowadays disability is viewed as an interaction between impairment, and attitudinal and environmental barriers. Therefore, disability now considered a social phenomenon. Keeping in mind the need and importance of efforts being made at the national and international level for PWD, the School of Education of the U P Rajarshi Tandon Open University, Prayagraj (U.P.) has decided to organize one day Conference on “Revised PWD Act-2016: Issues and Challenges in Implementation” in 19 January 2019.

Participants

Faculty members, Research Scholars, students, other academicians and representatives of Statuary Bodies and reputed NGOs and as well as professionals of special education will be invited to participate in the conference.

Stay and Meals
